Bowling alley/martini bar sets opening date

Downtown Cleveland's bowling alley/restaurant/martini bar is about ready to roll.

Corner Alley, at the southeast corner of Euclid Avenue and East 4th Street will open Thursday, Dec. 7, according to invitations for a special media event the week before.

The concept from Trifecta Management Group of Los Angeles will feature 16 bowling lanes, martini bar, a true-to-Euclid Avenue-history "Millionaires Row" VIP room and attached 100-seat restaurant known as the 4th Street Bar and Grill.

Corner Alley is part of Cleveland developer MRN Ltd.'s East 4th Street Neighborhood. Trifecta also operates the nearby Flannery's Pub and has plans to launch Zocalo, an upscale Mexican cantina.
